

OLD TOWN CHALLENGE

Participants are being divided into teams (6-12 teams). The leaders of each team is being determined and they get **t-shirt** from organizer which they have to wear trough the whole race, **flags** with number of team and logo sign, **digital camera** and envelope with written **directions and assignments** (exp. *On the enter of one of Dubrovnik's fortress is written: non bene pro toto libertas... Find that inscription and take a photo of it!*). Organizer's representative presents the race in short lines.

Rules:

The goal of the race „Old town challenge“ is to find given locations, take a photo with digital camera on them and come to agreed winning post. The winner is team that finds and takes photos of most locations in given time.

Locations are described in form of riddle that team has to solve to find out which location is given. The next step is to find the location (with help of people passing by..) and take a photo on it. On one of the cards in envelopes is description of place which is the winning post.

Each photographed location carries certain number of points (from 4 - 8 points). There is also a **BONUS** card which brings **bonus points** (+10 points), if you find it and take a photo of it. On each photograph there has to be a whole team, apart from the member who takes a photo. On each photo flag or commercial balloon has to be seen. Every location can be photographed by a different member of a team. You can take a photo of same location several times, but you have to take into consideration Camera's memory. In case there is a member of team or commercial (flag or balloon) missing on a photograph, team gets **negative points** (-1 point) for each shortage.

The race ends at the agreed time on the location described on one of the cards. Every delaying on the winning post is being punished with negative points (every 5 minutes -2 points). The leader of team reports to the Organizer's representative and gives digital camera on the review. Representative proclaims the winner and hands diplomas and prizes to the most successful team.
